

French Year 3 Greetings, Numbers, Colours – Autumn 1

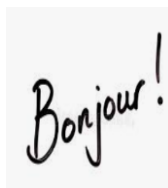
Prior Learning: Children might have acquired a few basic words throughout Foundation and Key Stage 1

Where is France?



France is a country located on the western edge of Europe.

What language do they speak?



French, the official language, is the first language of 88% of the population

4. TWAL: I can say numbers 1-10

In this lesson we will learn to count to 10 and use these numbers correctly. While we are doing this we will be identifying key sounds/silent letters and speaking confidently.



1. TWAL: I can pronounce some greetings in French

We will learn how to say hello and goodbye in different ways. When we are doing this we will try to identify key sounds/silent letters and speak confidently



5. TWAL: I can recall numbers 1-10

In this lesson you will be writing numbers in French accurately. We will be trying hard to write them from memory.



2. TWAL: I can ask and answer a question about how I am feeling

We will learn to say how we are feeling and ask someone how they are feeling. We will be aiming to ask questions accurately and speak confidently.



6. TWAL: I can say different colours in French

In this lesson we will listen to and read colours in French. We will be writing colours using a model. You will be aiming to join in enthusiastically.



3. TWAL: I can introduce myself in French

We will learn to say what our name is and how to ask someone else their name. When we are doing this we will be identifying key sounds/silent letters and speaking confidently.
