

## French - Year 3 – Carnival, using numbers, Easter time – Spring 2

Prior Learning: Children have learnt about numbers before

### Easter in France:

Children take place in an Easter egg hunt (Chasse aux Oeufs) organised by parents or sometimes clubs or local communes. Chocolate and/or decorated eggs are hidden in the garden or park, then children go and hunt for the hidden eggs.



### 4. TWAL: I can take part in a simple dialogue about myself

In this lesson we will learn how to put phrases together to create a dialogue about ourselves. We will try to recall and use previously learnt language and identify key sounds and silent letters.



### 1. TWAL: I can learn about French traditions and take part in carnival celebrations

In this lesson we will learn about French traditions and take part in a carnival celebration. We will try hard to join in with games, ask questions and have a positive attitude.

### 5. TWAL: I can read and write dates in French

We will be learning how to read and write the date in French. We will play games and then write some dates in our book.



When writing the date, the month **doesn't** start with a capital letter.

### 2. TWAL: I can say and write some numbers between 1-15.

We will learn numbers 1-15 numbers by playing games and doing some multiplications. We will try to imitate pronunciation of sounds and recall previously learnt language.

### 6. TWAL: I can understand and use Easter vocabulary

In this lesson we will be learning about Easter by playing some games. We will try to listen attentively and take risks.



### 3. TWAL: I can ask and answer 'How old are you?'

We will practise using numbers by learning to ask and answer – 'How old are you? We will try to listen attentively and ask questions accurately.
