Prior Learning: In Year 3 children will have - learnt how to introduce themselves, ask how someone is, days of the weeks, months and colours

## French Schools:

The school day is generally longer than in the UK but the holidays are longer. Lessons usually start around 8.30 in the morning. Pupils have at least one hour and a half for lunch and usually finish school around 16.30. The French school year numbering system in secondary school works in descending order.



## 4. TWAL: I can remember days and months

Remember days and months in French

In this lesson we will revise days and months. We will be trying hard to remember them. We will be trying to make links from other languages and learn from our mistakes.





1. <u>TWAL: I can ask and answer several questions about myself</u> We will revise greetings and asking/answering questions about ourselves. We

We will revise numbers 1-10 and classroom instructions. We will be trying to identify key sounds and silent letters.



## 3. TWAL: I can say and read numbers 0-20

In this lesson we will be checking that you know numbers 1-10 and learning numbers 10-20. We will be trying to identify patterns.



## 5. <u>TWAL: I can say and write the names of rooms in my school</u>

We will learn how to say and write the names of rooms in a school. In this lesson we will practise using a bilingual dictionary.

6. TWAL: I can say and write nouns for classroom items

In this lesson we will try to learn 4 classroom objects in French. We will also aim to use a bilingual dictionary to help our understanding.
