Epiphany in France:

The 6th of January is 'l'Epiphanie' or 'la journée des rois' and commemorates the visit of the three wise men to baby Jesus. It's traditional in France to eat 'la Galette des Rois'. French people will go to the bakery to buy this king's cake or make it themselves.



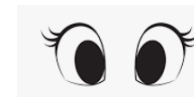
4. TWAL: I can understand and say some parts of the face

We will learn to understand and say some parts of the face. We will try to listen attentively and imitate pronunciation.



Plural – les

Singular – la/le



1. TWAL: I am learning about Epiphany celebrations in France

In this lesson, we will be learning some facts about Epiphany in France and making links between some sounds and spellings. We will try to identify sounds and silent letters.



5. TWAL: I can understand simple sentences using numbers and parts of the face

We will learn how to turn singular nouns into plural nouns. We will learn how to write descriptions using numbers. We will try to understand basic grammar and identify sounds and silent letters.

2. TWAL: I can say the nouns of 4 family members

We will read a story and complete activities to learn the names of family members.



The word 'parent' means not just 'parent' as in mother or father but also relative. It is a noun and adjective.

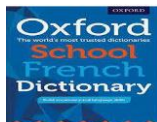
6. TWAL: I can write some simple sentences to describe an alien
