### French – Year 4 – Feeling unwell/jungle animals – Summer 1

Prior Learning: Children have learnt parts of the body, common animals and colours.

#### **Doctors in France:**

The current cost of a standard visit to a GP (general practitioner) in France is 25 euros. Visits to specialists and to the hospital cost more, as do home visits and visits at night and weekends.

# 4. TWAL: I can understand a story. I can understand adjectives to describe jungle animals.

We will listen to a story and learn adjectives to describe jungle animals. We will try hard to make an educated guess using context.

# 1. TWAL: I can remember parts of the body and explain why I don't feel well or what hurts.

We will revisit parts of the body and learn how to explain that we don't feel well or what hurts. We will play games and do a match it activity. We will try to speak confidently, listen attentively and identify key sounds and silent letters.

# 5. TWAL: I can write sentences using nouns and adjectives to describe animals

We will write sentences about animals using a model. We will use a bilingual dictionary to look up new words and make links with English.

### 2. TWAL: I can take part in a role play dialogue at the doctors

We will listen to a song, play a game and write a doctor/patient dialogue with a partner. We will aim to speak confidently, take risks and enjoy practicing new language with a friend.



Adjectives agree with the noun they describe. The spelling of the adjective can change if you are describing a **le** or la noun.

### 6. TWAL: I can write my own jungle explorer story

In this lesson we will write our own jungle story using a model. We will try to take risks, speak confidently and use a bilingual dictionary.



When using a bilingual dictionary don't forget many words have more than one meaning. Don't just take the first translation, read on...

#### 3. I can understand and name jungle animals

We will play games and complete a worksheet to learn the names of some jungle animals. We will try to speak confidently and listen attentively.
