

French – Year 5 – Healthy Eating (going to the market/fruit salad recipe) – Spring 1

Prior Learning: In year 3/4 children learnt about fruit and vegetables.

Markets in France:

Virtually every French town has its covered market (marché couvert), which is a permanent structure, occupied by an array of market stalls; in a classic "marché couvert", sometimes called "les Halles", most of the stalls will sell fresh fruit and vegetables.



4. TWAL: I can ask for the price of a fruit or vegetable

We will practice numbers and then learn how to ask the price of different fruit and vegetables. We will play a game to help us learn this. We will be trying to recall previously learnt language and ask questions accurately.



The euro is the official currency of France, which is a member of the European Union.

1. TWAL: I can recall fruits and vegetables

In this lesson we will recall the names of fruit and vegetables. We will try to remember if the noun is masculine or feminine. We will be trying to use a bilingual dictionary.



Remember when using a bilingual dictionary – m=male and f=female

5. TWAL: I can participate in a simple shopping conversation

In this lesson we will learn some phrases for a simple conversation. We will then try to use these phrases to write our own conversations. We will be trying to ask questions accurately and take risks.



2. TWAL: I can talk about and write about fruits and vegetables

We will be learning how to say which fruits and vegetables we like and don't like. We will be trying to join in with games, recall language and take risks.



6. TWAL: I can understand and use instructions for my own recipe.

We will learn the vocabulary for instructions and then combine this with our fruit knowledge to create a recipe. We will make educated guesses and use a bilingual dictionary.



3. TWAL: I can take part in a class survey about favourite fruits and vegetables

In this lesson we will use all our knowledge about fruit and vegetables to carry out a class survey. We will take risks and recall previously taught language.
