1. TWAL: I can understand the nouns for items I take to the beach

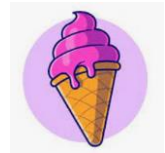
In this lesson we will learn about beaches in France and the names of items that we take to the beach. We will be using a bilingual dictionary and speaking confidently.



t, s and e are silent letters in French

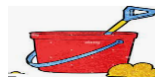
5. TWAL: I can read and understand facts about the seaside

2. TWAL: I can recall some sentence starters and use them to talk about the seaside.

We will revisit sentence starters and learn nouns, verbs and adjectives related to the seaside. We will be speaking confidently and recalling previously learnt language.



6. TWAL: I can apply my language detective skills to learn another language

In this lesson we will use our skills to decode French and Spanish! We will imitate pronunciation of sounds, identify key sounds and join in with games.



3. TWAL: I can understand and say persuasive sentences about visiting the seaside.

In this lesson you will make and perform a spoken advert about the seaside. You will make links with English, take risks and learn from mistakes.
