

French - Year 6 – Revisiting me, telling the time and daily life – Autumn 1

Prior Learning: Children have learnt about basic feelings, how to talk about themselves and numbers

Daily life in France:

A typical workday begins at 9:00 a.m. However, lunchbreak in France can last up to two hours. So, a lot of French businesses will be closed between 12:30 and 2:00 pm. However, this means that French people are generally done with work later too. A usual day would finish around 6 pm.



4. TWAL: I can understand o'clock time phrases

We will learn how to ask someone for the time and how to say the time when it is o'clock.

1. TWAL: I can recall phrases to talk about myself and my feelings

In this lesson we will be reading, understanding and saying sentences about ourselves. We will also try to understand a poem about what we are like. We will try hard to listen attentively and speak confidently.

5. TWAL: I can talk about my daily routine

We will learn about daily routine phrases and write a description of someone's routine. We will be trying to speak confidently.



2. TWAL: I can give a simple description about myself

We will talk about ourselves by extending our knowledge about feelings. Then we will learn about adjectives to describe personality and appearance. We will be trying to speak confidently and use a bilingual dictionary.



Adjectives are spelt differently depending on whether the noun is masculine or feminine

6. TWAL: I can ask questions about my daily routine

In this lesson we will learn how to ask and answer questions about simple daily routine activities. We will focus on asking the questions accurately.



3. TWAL: I can remember and use numbers to 60

In this lesson we will recap numbers that we already know and learn numbers to 60. We will try to make links with English and imitate pronunciation of sounds.
