We will play games to learn how to use the verb jouer. We will try to make links with English.




In French the verb ending changes when a different person is doing the action.

In this lesson we will play games and do an activity to help us remember the names of some sports. We will try to makes links with English, speak confidently and listen attentively.




In this lesson we will use models to talk about and write about different sports. We will try to speak confidently, listen attentively and take risks.
