

French –Year 6 – Café culture and restaurants – Summer 1

Prior Learning: Children have prior learning of food and shopping.

Are cafes popular in France?

There is perhaps nothing more Parisian than taking a few moments out of your day to sit with an espresso in one of the city's thousands of cafes. Whether you're nestled indoors on a cosy banquette or lounging out on a sunny terrace, drinking and people-watching is one of the most cherished past-times in France.



4. TWAL: I can name traditional French breakfast food and drinks. I can write a simple sentence about my favourite breakfast.

We will learn about a traditional French breakfast and then write a sentence about what we like to eat for breakfast.



A typical French breakfast is light, sweet, and fairly simple. It's usually made up of breakfast cereals, a tartine (slice of bread with topping) and a drink (tea, coffee, orange juice). It's usually eaten between 6 AM and 8 AM

1. TWAL: I can learn about 'café culture' and learn some typical food and drinks

We will learn about cafes in France and why they are important. We will also learn the names of some food and drink that you can buy.



The 'on' sound is a nasal sound. The sound must come from your nose.

5. TWAL: I can create and describe a hotel breakfast

In this lesson we will learn about all the different types of hotel breakfasts and then create our own. We will try to make educational guesses using the context and recall and use previously learnt language.

2. TWAL: I can say and write food/drinks that I like/dislike. I can ask someone about their likes/dislikes

In this lesson we will revisit the names of different food and drinks. We will say what we like and dislike and ask others. We will try to speak confidently and ask questions accurately.



6. TWAL: I can take part in a café role play and write the conversation.

In this lesson we are going to practise everything we have learnt and create our own role play about the café. We will aim to speak confidently, make educated guesses using the context and ask questions accurately.



3. TWAL: I can order café food and drinks politely

We will learn how to order food and drinks in a café. We will aim to speak confidently and ask questions accurately. We will start to understand basic grammar.
