

Design and create your own Titanic!

Your challenge is to design and create a model of the Titanic. You will need to label it, showing clearly the different parts of your ship. A design sheet can be found below.

Once you have designed it and labelled it, you will need to consider what you are going to make it from. You might like to use things you have around the home, or clean litter that might otherwise be recycled. It could be made from yoghurt pots, cereal boxes, toilet roll tubes... be as creative as you like! You could even create it using Lego!

Below are some of the examples made by children last year in Year 3. They are all unique and reflect the creativity of the children that made them. How will you create yours?



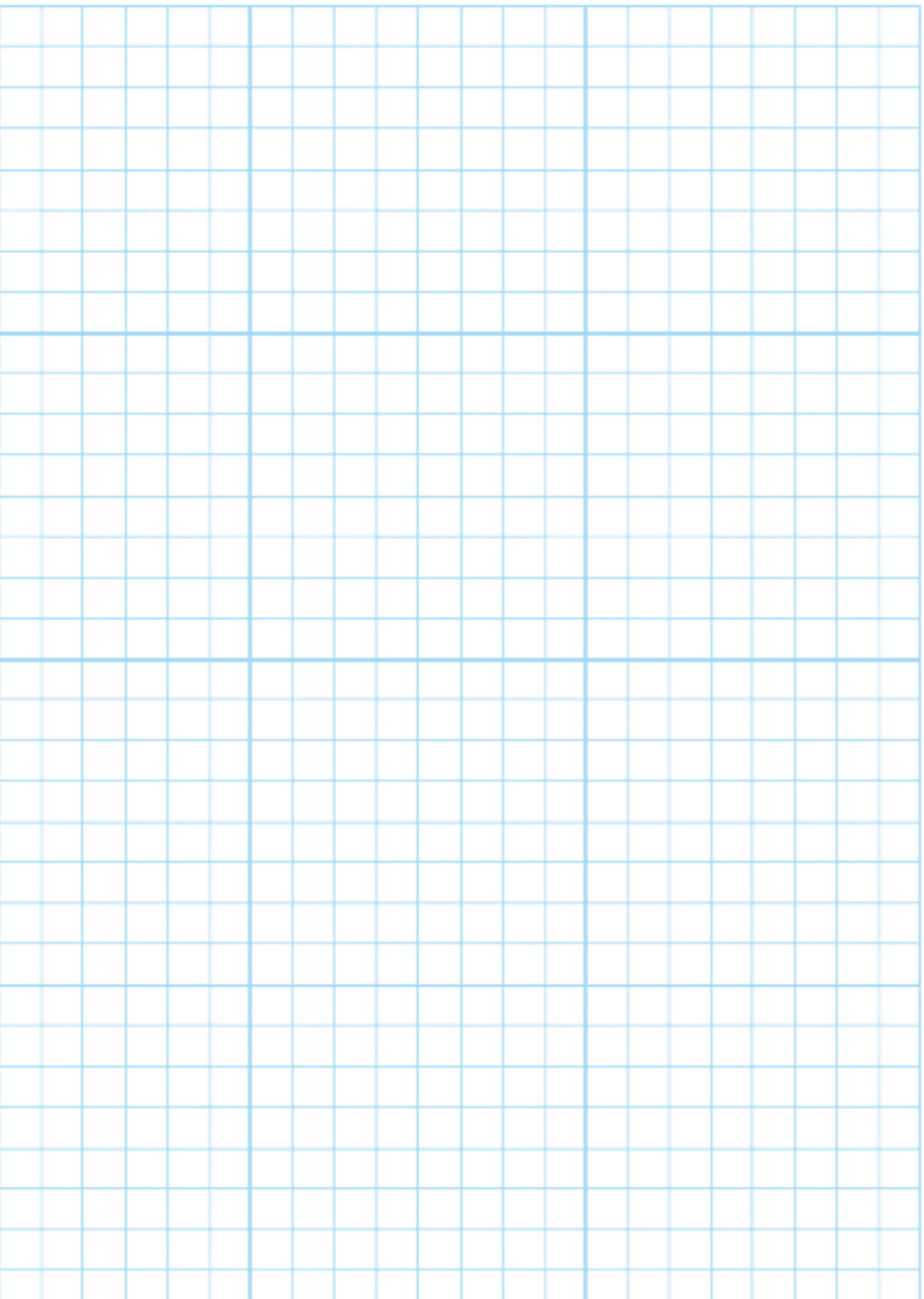
