### Words we will know!



#### 1. Communicate

TWAL: to communicate our understanding of the end of a journey.

We will be able to talk about our own responses to *journey's end* using our own experiences.



A journey is travelling from one place to another.

#### 5. Evaluate

TWAL: to evaluate the importance of Journey's end to Christians.

We will talk about the importance of the journeys' end to Christians.

#### 2. Apply

TWAL: to apply different journey's ends to our lives.

We will be able to identify how different journey's ends relate to our lives and discuss how they make us feel.

Theme: Nativity Journeys

Concept: Journey's end

We will explore journey's end in the Christian nativity story. Each character had a different journey but ended in the same place.



#### 4. Contextualise

TWAL: to contextualise journey's end through the Christian Nativity story.

We will recognise the journey's end of the characters in the Christmas birth narratives. *Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem, The shepherds and The Magi.*



The Christian Nativity story is told in the 4 gospels of the Bible.

#### 3. Inquire

TWAL: to inquire about Journey's End.

We will identify and talk about different journeys' ends through the story of Baboushka.
