1. Communicate

TWAL: to discuss our knowledge of candle light.

We will be able to talk about our own responses to candlelight after observing a lit candle and reading 'Teddy's Birthday' by Amanda Davidson.

5. Evaluate

Theme: Light helps people to remember

Key question: Why is light important at Hanukkah and

TWAL: to evaluate the importance of candlelight.

We will be able to explain why it is important to have candles for us, Jewish people and Christians.

4. Contextualise

TWAL: what Christians use an advent wreath for.

We will read Advent poem to discover what use candle on the Advent Wreath symbolises.

We will discover that the Advent Wreath is important to Christians because it reminds them of God's promise of everlasting life.



The Advent wreath reminds Christians to wait and prepare for Christmas.

2. Apply

TWAL: to apply our knowledge of candles.

We will identify how candles can be used in our own lives to help us remember things.



Candles can be used to remember something.

4. Contextualise

Advent?

TWAL: to contextualise candlelight in the Jewish faith.

We will read the Hanukkah story and learn that the festival of Hanukkah celebrates the belief in the miracle of one small jar of oil lasting 8 nights instead of 1 night as usual.

A Jewish Menorah has 9 candles, one for each night of the 8 nights of the festival of Hanukkah plus a helper candle.

3. Inquire

TWAL: to inquire about a Hannukkiah

We will explore a Hanukkiah. We will ask questions to discover more.

A Hannukiah is a special Jewish menorah lamp to remind Jews of the miracle of the oil at

Hanukkah.

3. Inquire

TWAL: to inquire about an Advent wreath.

We will explore an Advent ring and ask questions to discover more.

An Advent wreath/ring has 4 candles that are lit on the 4 Sunday's leading up to Christmas.
