1. Communicate- What places are special to me?  
TWAL: to communicate our ideas about special places.

We will share our ideas about places that are special to us. We will be able to identify why a place is special to us.

5. Evaluate- Is it important to have a special place?  
TWAL: to evaluate the importance of churches for Christians.
