#### 1. Communicate

We will be able to evaluate, by explaining, the value of believers' interpretations of God.

#### 2. Apply

TWAL: to apply our understanding of God to different situations.

We will be able to explain how interpretations of God change in different circumstances.

Theme: How do people perceive God?

Concept: Interpretation

We will look at how Christians and believers of one other religion of our choice interpret the word God. God means different things to different people from different religions.

#### 4. Contextualise

TWAL: to contextualise God through another religion.

We will choose another religion to research and discover how they interpret God.

#### 3. Inquire

TWAL: to Inquire into interpretation.

We will be able to explain the meaning of interpretation.



Interpretation means to explain the meaning of something, which can mean different things to different people.

TWAL: to contextualise God through Christianity.

We will be able to explain how Christians interpret God through exploring statements of belief.
