KS1 Seasonal changes

Throughout Year 1 the children learn about each season as it is happening- through observing the environment outside (with Mrs Davies as part of outdoor learning sessions and during class discussions at various times). For example we took a photo of the same tree in each season- what were the changes in the environment, changes in what we were wearing. This will then feed into the unit we do in Summer 2 and use information we have gathered through the year for comparison.
