

Year 3 Topic: Everyone Plays Ukulele (Summer 2)

Prior Learning: In Year Three we have learned how to keep a steady beat and copy rhythms • How to sing together with confidence

In this unit we will learn how to hold and strum a ukulele. We will learn the different finger positions to play 3 chords and will use the ukuleles to accompany our singing.



4. TWAL To play a song with a changing chord pattern

We will recap our learning so far and will play the song from Lesson 3 with the chord changes from F to C, following the colour of the words. We will learn the finger position to play a G chord.

1. TWAL To strum all the strings and pluck each one separately

We will learn the different parts of the ukulele and will hold it correctly, strumming it gently with our thumb. We will sing a song with the strumming and then play it again, plucking each string separately.

5. TWAL To play a song with a changing chord pattern

We will recap our learning so far and add in a song that changes from C to G.

2. TWAL To form a C chord with the correct finger position

We will recap the pieces from Lesson 1 and learn to place our finger on the C chord. We will sing some songs that use C and learn where our fingers need to be for an F chord.

6. TWAL To play a song from Hawaii

We will recap our learning so far and add it a Hawaiian song with chord changes.

3. TWAL To form an F chord with the correct finger position

We will practise forming an F chord and learn a song which use this chord. We will look at a song with changing chords and play it in two groups.
