

Year 5 Topic: Intro to Garage Band (Summer 2)

Prior Learning: In Year Five we have already learned to improvise to a backing track

In this unit we will use GarageBand on the iPads to choose, order and manipulate sounds. After working on different instruments, we will compose a piece of music.



4. TWAL To create a layered backing track

We will learn how to add tracks to the screen and create a score with drums, bass and guitar.



Know how to add and delete layers

1. TWAL To explore Drums

We will learn to use the Smart Drums and the acoustic kit on GarageBand, before playing in time along with a track.

5. TWAL To compose our own "Superhero" or "Supervillain" music

We will use GarageBand to create a layered piece, which is exciting and dramatic and uses some of the techniques we have learned.

2. TWAL To explore Guitars

We will explore Chords and Notes on acoustic and electric guitars on GarageBand, before learning a chord sequence and playing along with a track.

6. TWAL To compose our own "Superhero" or "Supervillain" music

We will continue working on our pieces. At the end of the lesson we will listen to everyone's compositions.

3. TWAL To explore Keyboards

We will go over the layout of a keyboard and explore some of the different voices available on GarageBand. We will then learn a melody and try to play it fluently.
