

Year 1 Topic: World Music Tour (Summer 1)

Prior Learning: In Year One we have sung together, listened to music and talked about how different instruments are played

Concepts:
Singing
Playing
Listening

Musicianship

In this unit we will take a trip around the world, listening to music from different countries, learning some songs and creating our own music based on what we hear.



4. TWAL About music from China

We will watch a zither being played and listen to a story from China, before using chime bars to play some pentatonic melodies.

1. TWAL About music from Trinidad and Tobago

We will watch some steel pans being played, sing a Caribbean game song together, identify instruments and play along to a track.

5. TWAL About music from India

We will watch a sitar being played and listen to a story from India. We will compose sounds for different parts of the story and follow a graphic score to know when to play.

2. TWAL About music from Senegal

We will watch some djembes being played, sing a Senegalese song and play some rhythm patterns on bucket drums.



Know that “ta” means play one sound and “te-te” means to play two faster sounds

6. TWAL About music from Australia

We will watch a didgeridoo being played, learn a song about Australian animals and use instruments to create sounds for a traditional Australian story.

3. TWAL About music from Japan

We will watch some Taiko drums being played, learn a Japanese song and played some rhythm patterns with drumsticks.
