Literacy—Writing

- Autumn will be all about mark making, big and small! We will learning sounds in phonics and then trying our hardest to form them in lots of different ways!
- We will be making our bodies, arms and fingers stronger with lots of gross and fine motor activities so that we are ready for writing!









Phonics

With 'Little Wandle' Phonics children will:

- Practise getting ready to learn with good sitting, good listening and good looking!
- We will start learning sounds, how to say them and begin blending.

Understanding the World

- Exploring and adventure all the way! We will be getting to know our environment and exploring the classrooms, outside area and school grounds.
- We will also learn lots of new things about our friends, similarities and differences

PSHE

 Autumn time will see us learning about how we learn at school, thinking about keeping safe and following rules and routines to ensure we are always read to learn and grow.



Literacy— Reading

- The children will be introduced to our reading areas, both inside and out and will be given lots of opportunities to explore books independently and during while class learning time.
- We will share stories about starting school and exploring who we are and what makes us so special!







Maths

- Maths will be taught through sensory play, songs, games, activities and whole class learning. We will undertaking the NCTEM Numberblocks series and White Rose maths to begin our journey of understanding numbers to 10
- We will be looking at 2D shapes and begin using language to compare and measure things in our environment.



Expressive Art and Design

- Music sessions with Mrs Thompsett playing instruments and make up songs
- Role play & small world imaginative play— Looking at homes and things that are important to us.
- Exploring all the creative areas inside and out!

PE and PD

Using 'Real PE' the children will be working on : Personal Skills

We will also be working on our gross motor control as we explore different ways of moving.
