English

- The children will study the story Beegu. The children will be writing a character description using and, because and expanded noun phrases.
- Then the children will study the story 'Astro Girl.' The children will learn how to use plurals and the suffixes er and est to write a non-fiction fact file.

PSHE

The children will learn how information is stored and used. They will learn how to assess and access the reliability of information and how to protect themselves on line.

RE
