Amongst other skills we will apply:

- Conjunctions
- Speech punctuation
- Expanding noun phrases with prepositions

Reading

We will be reading 'Fortunately the Milk' by Neil Gaiman

We will be continuing to practise our reading skills:

- fetch, inference, human dictionary, summary, links

French

We will be continuing our French lessons—we will be learning the vocabulary for colours, classroom commands and Noel

Maths

- Addition and Subtraction using 3 digit numbers
- Mental Maths—Timestables knowledge

RE

We are looking at the concept of Angels and their place in the Christian Christmas story.

Art

We will be sketching from observations and looking at still life drawing through Dutch Masters

PSHE

This half term we are looking at Keeping Safe in our local environment—#WWSafe. We will be using St Johns Ambulance to help us with our first aid skills.

Science

We are learning about

- Forces
- Magnetism—exploring poles of magnets and investigating attract and repel concept

Music

In Music the children are going to be learning to drum and to prepare for the Christmas Christingle service.

Geography

This half term we are looking at our local area using maps and thinking about what has changed in our environment.
