Spring 2 Learning

English

We will be looking at the following texts:

- Jabberwocky
- Varjak Paw

We will be writing a nonsense poem as well as a nonchronological report.

French

In French, we will be learning how to say face and body parts in French.

RE

We are going to look at the Christian belief that Jesus was tempted by the devil. We will link this to making choices in our lives.

PSHE

We will learn how to make positive choices that keep us healthy. This will include how be a good friend and recognising their feelings.

Science

We will be exploring the different states of matter and investigating how the can change state. We will be learning about the water cycle.

Reading
