English

We will be creating pieces of writing inspired by the poem Sympathy by Paul Laurence Dunbar and a fascinating book called Hidden Figures by Margot-Lee Shetterley

French

We will be learning about the French capital city, Paris. We will also be learning how to use French to help us travel around as the children will learn how to ask for directions and how to buy a ticket.

Music

In Music the children will be learning about different musical structures. They will look at how longer pieces of music can be organised and will work on their skills recognising instrument sounds and changes in music using musical vocabulary. We will be preparing songs for our Christingle.

PSHE

We will be learning how to be safe in different areas of our lives. We will cover:

- What is discrimination?
- How bullying can effect someone's life
- Consent
- Personal boundaries
- First aid & basic life support

RE

We will be learning about the concept of interpretation through two different narratives about Jesus' birth. We will also reflect on our understanding of interpretations of different situations.

Reading

We will develop our inference skills and begin to think about the effect of the language the author has chosen.

Maths

The children will be looking at:

- Multiplication and division
- Area and perimeter
- Problem solving

History

We will be looking at Early Islamic Civilisations focussing on:

- How did religion effect beliefs?
- Why was Baghdad important?
- What else was happening in the world?

Science

We will be learning about different forces such as gravity, air resistance, water resistance and friction. We will be conducting lots of investigations to further our understanding.

DT

We will be baking a seasonal crumble using different cooking skills and understanding such as:

- The nutritional value in desserts
- The impact of seasonality on our food
- What flavours we like in a crumble
- Evaluating what we have made

PE (recommended clothes—trainers, shorts, T-Shirt, jogging bottoms, tracksuit top)

Using 'Real PE' the children will be working on skills:

- Social and fundamental movement skills
- Working on our collaborative skills, organising roles and responsibilities during different movement skills
