English

We will be focusing on the themes of nerve, suspense and mystery. We will be looking at texts such as Phillip Pullman's 'Clockwork' to produce imaginative and cohesive works that will thrill the reader using a variety of techniques to build atmosphere and emotion.

Reading

Children will be answering VIPERS questioning and practicing fluency and confidence in reading. Through this approach the children will be able to access and answer a wide range of questions on a variety of high quality texts.

Music

In Music this half term we will be using our set of keyboards to learn the basics of playing the instruments. The children will learn note names, simple finger patterns and learn to play some simple melodies, reading from music notes.

Maths

The children will be looking at: Fractions, decimals and percentages and how to apply this knowledge to a range of mathematical questions and concepts.

PSHE

We cover how information is stored and used, how to assess and access the reliability of information and to be able to protect ourselves on line by understanding the influences of extreme views within the 'Digital Literacy and Communication' theme of our PSHE Education.

Geography

Children will learn about the continent of South America before zooming in to look at Brazil in more detail. They will use map work and compass directions to locate cities, before learning about the differences in physical and human geography as well as trade links between Brazil and the UK.

RE

We will be looking at how people perceive God through the concept 'interpretation' We will be doing this by looking at what God means to different people and how Christians interpret the word of God.

Science

We will be learning about light sources and how rays of light travel. We will learn how to manipulate light using mirrors and attempt to make our own periscopes.

Art

Comic books films have been at the forefront of the film industry for the last ten years, but did you know that comic book art has been popular for nearly a century? During this module we will learn more about how comic book characters were drawing, and the common features found in superhero comics.
