

# Art Year 3 Summer 2 Pattern and Shape Concept: pattern

Prior Learning: In KS1, children will learned what a pattern is, and looked at repetition of pattern through shape, colour and imagery.

## Let's discover some new artists.



Paul Klee

Paul Klee was a Swiss artist who was inspired by cubism and surrealism.



Wassily Kandinsky

Kandinsky was a famous Russian Artist who many call the pioneer of abstract art.

## 4. TWAL: about the abstract art of Kandinsky.

Kandinsky also used shapes a lot in his abstract art. We will discuss what abstract art is, and why people might make artwork that just has shapes and colours in it!



Abstract art doesn't focus on a specific object, scene or person.

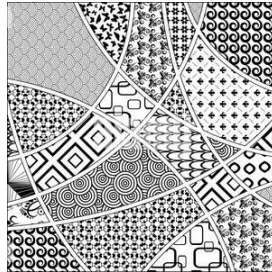


## 1. TWAL: How shapes are used in Art?

In this lesson we will talk about the 2D shapes we know, and how they can be used in art. We will look at a type of art called Zentangle and have a go at replicating some of the shapes we see.



When shapes fit together without any gaps that is called tessellating pattern.



## 5. TWAL: to create a painting inspired by Kandinsky

We will use all our knowledge and research on geometric shapes to create an abstract piece of art using a range of shapes, lines and colours.



## 2. TWAL: about the features of Paul Klee's art.

In this lesson we will learn a bit about the artist Paul Klee and find out why shapes and patterns were so important in his artworks. We will look at a range of his artworks and see what shapes we can find! We will look at how he has used colours and simple shapes to remind us of images of people and places.



## 6. TWAL: to evaluate our use of shape in our artwork.

We will evaluate our artwork and decide what we liked, what skills we have learned and what we will improve next time. We will comment on our texture, shape and accuracy.



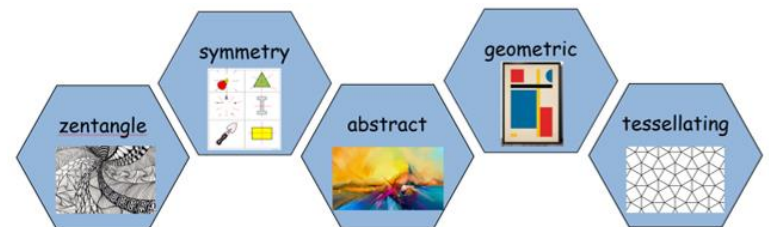
Great artists can say what they like and what they would do better next time!
