Why go on a Residential in Year 6?



- It promotes the importance of allowing children to connect with the outdoor world.
- As well as the physical health benefits, school residentials have been proven to have a positive effect on children's self esteem, resilience and confidence levels, thereby improving their emotional health and well being... 78% of KS2 pupils felt more confident to try new things after a residential.
- It is hugely beneficial to allow children to explore their environment, take responsibility and generally look after themselves with minimal obvious adult intervention. Even the down time of a residential where children can relax, play and reflect is hugely important in allowing children to continue to discover who they are.
- Residential trips offer a unique opportunity for children to claim their independence, make their own decisions and build friendships/ deepen bonds with their peers and teachers.
- Residential experiences improve students' engagement with learning and knowledge, their skills and understanding... In long-term follow-up studies, 82% of KS2 pupils said their teachers and lessons on Residential helped them to learn.
- They boost cohesion and a sense of belonging
- Residential learning experiences **'provide opportunities, benefits and impacts that cannot be achieved in any other context or setting.** The impact is greater when residentials are fully integrated into a school's curriculum' (Learning Away Project 2015)

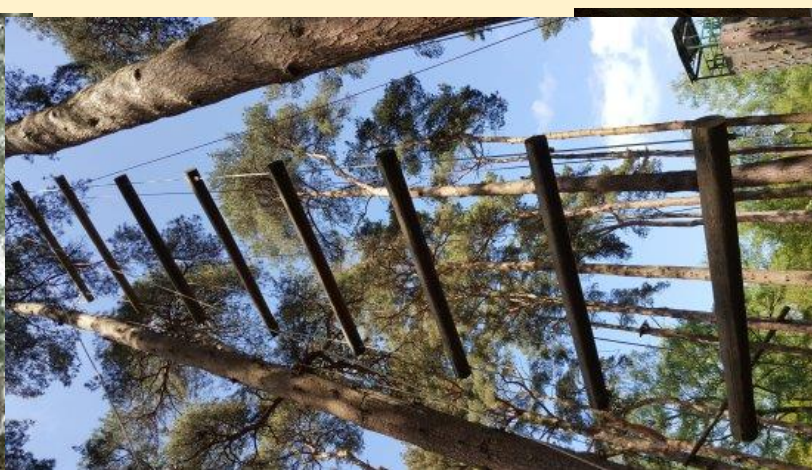




What the children say.....




I conquered my fear of heights by going
