English

- The children will study the story 'Lila and the secret of the rain'. The children will be extending their writing skills to include more detail.
- Then the children will study the video 'The Clock Tower' The children will have a go at using questions in their writing and extend their sentences using 'and'.

Reading

The children will be practising the following skills:

- Accuracy using phonics knowledge
- Fluency using expression
- Retrieval

Using a variety of both fiction and non-fiction texts.

PSHE

We will learn about having positive mental health. We will learn about different kinds of feelings; strategies to manage big feelings and what to do if you feel lonely.

Maths

The children will learn about:

- Length and height
- Mass and volume
- Multiplication and division

RE

We will be learning about Guru Nanak and the Gurus . We will talk about wisdom and how the Gurus show it.

History

We will learn about the Victorian seaside. We will look at changes within living memory to the aspect of national life – The Seaside.

Design and Technology

We will learn about where different fruits come from, then we will be designing and making our own fruit smoothies. We will be trying our smoothies and evaluating them.

Science

The children will become 'Plant Detectives. We will be growing plants, labelling flowers and learning about the different types of trees.

Music

The children will be learning about high and low pitch using their voices and a variety of instruments.

Phonics

The children will continue to learn phase 5 phonics and the alternative spellings for sounds. They will continue to learn new tricky words.

Spelling

The children will be learning how to apply their new sounds in spellings.

PE

Using 'Real PE' the children will be working on skills in :

- Agility and static balance
- Outdoor Adventure activities

Computing

We will be learning how to make a floor robot move. We will have fun programming it to carry out different activities and try and get it to follow a route.
