# Summer 1 Learning

## English

We will be looking at the text:

Secrets of a Sun King

Egyptian Myths & Mummies Unwrapped

We will continue to apply our writing skills of fronted adverbials, possessive apostrophes, and to use a rich and varied vocabulary to write a diary entry.

## Reading

We will be reading *Secrets of a Sun King* by Emma Carroll (as well as other relevant shorter texts) and focusing on reading with fluency and expression, and practising our key reading skills.

## French

In French this term we will be exploring features of a jungle. The children will be able to name animals and be able to describe them.

## Maths

We will be learning about:

- Decimals
- Money
- Time

## RE

We will be looking at the Hindu festival Holi, learning about the concepts of good and evil and the story of Hiranyakashyap, Prahlad and Vishnu.

## Music

In music lessons, the children have another chance to play our set of ukuleles. We will revisit the chords C and F which we learned in Y3 and will add the chord of G. We will follow pitch notation

## PSHE

We will learn how to make positive choices that keep us healthy. This will include how to be a good friend and recognising their feelings.

## History

We will continue to learn about the Ancient Egyptians, spending time looking at their legacy and achievements in Architecture, Technology, Language and Engineering. This will include an Egyptian Day.

## Science & DT

These subjects are closely linked, with both looking at Electrical Circuits. We will learn how switches work to complete a circuit as well as considering the safety and danger of working with Electricity. The topic will conclude with the children designing and making a circuit for practical use.

## PE

Using 'Real PE' the children will be working on skills:

- Outdoor Adventure Activities (team skills)
- Agility & static balance
