We will be looking at the text: Secrets of a Sun King Egyptian Myths & Mummies Unwrapped We will continue to apply our writing skills of fronted adverbials, possessive apostrophes, and to use a rich and varied vocabulary to write a diary entry.	We will be reading Secrets of a Sun King by Emma Carrol (as well as other relevant shorter texts) and focusing on reading with fluency and expression, and practising our key reading skills.
French	Maths
In French this term we will be exploring features of a jungle. The children will be able to name animals and be able to describe them.	We will be learning about: • Decimals • Money • Time
RE	Music
We will be looking at the Hindu festival Holi, learning about the concepts of good and evil and the story of Hiranyakashyap, Prahlad and Vishnu.	In music lessons, the children have another chance to play our set of ukuleles. We will revisit the chords C and F which we learned in Y3 and will add the chord of G. We will follow pitch notation
PSHE	History
We will learn how to make positive choices that keep us healthy. This will include how be a good friend and recognising their feelings. Science & DT
