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Literacy—Writing

We are very excited to start 'Drawing Club' this half term. Children will be introduced to the joy of many stories, animations and traditional tales and will be invited to join drawing club to share their ideas and learn a fantastic amount of new vocabulary.

We will share our Drawing Club focus and new vocabulary with you each week on Tapestry.



Phonics

With 'Little Wandle' Phonics children will:

- Recap all sounds learned so far.
- Continue to learn to blend sounds together to read words.
- Learn new sounds: j, w, v, x, y, z
- Learn some digraphs (two letters, one sound): ff, ss, II, zz qu, ch, sh, th, ng, nk
- Recap previously learned tricky words: is, I, the
- Learn new tricky words: put, pull, full, as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to, into, she, push, he, of, we, be, me
- We would love you to come along to our parent workshop on <u>Friday 10th Nov</u> to learn more about how we teach phonics and reading.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- This half-term, we will be learning how to work alongside our friends and see if we can work out how to play and learn whilst supporting each other.
- We will be talking in class about our school value 'Community' and how this is important to us.

Literacy— Reading

The children will begin to bring home their Little Wandle reading book each Friday. These will be matched to the sounds they have already learned and they will have read it in school three times, so should be familiar with them.

Children will also start to visit the school library and bring home a 'love for reading' book for you to share with them.

Every day in class we will continue to have a book vote and read the winning story before home time.



Maths

- Maths will be taught through sensory play, songs, games, activities and whole class learning. We will continue using NCTEM Numberblocks series to develop our journey of understanding numbers to 10.
- We will be looking at subitising, repeating AB patterns and making shapes from other shapes! Measuring outside will be taught using the language of comparing.



Understanding the World

We will continue to explore the changes in the seasons when learning outside and will learn about what living creatures can be found in our garden and the Nature Zone!

Expressive Art and Design

Music sessions with Mrs Thompsett—playing instruments and learning some new songs ready for our Christmas performance!

PE and PD Using 'Real PE' the children will be working on : Personal Skills

I enjoy working on simple tasks with help.

Movement Skills: Footwork and one-leg static balances.

We will also be working on our gross motor control as we explore different ways of moving, balancing and negotiating space!
