Y5 Experience Day: Early Islamic Civilisation

Year 5 pupils have an exciting opportunity to learn more about our history topic (Early Islamic Civilisation) when an expert visitor comes to school after half term on **Wednesday 15th November**.

The children will all experience workshops, hosted by Altru Theatre Company, which will help bring this period of history to life. The workshops will consist of fun, interactive, physical drama activities which will explore the topic in hand (Early Islamic Civilisation). The children will take part in scene setter activities, knowledge games and performance tasks which will all help build on their knowledge of the topic at the same time as helping with their own personal confidence, communication skills and team work.

The main learning points covered within the workshops are as follows:

- The timeline of Early Islam
- The ancient, walled city of Baghdad
- Important buildings including: The Dome of the Rock and The Great Mosque
- Key figures including Al-Khwarizmi
- The Abbasid Caliphate and the Mongol Invasion
