Thursday 25th May – Years 3, 4, 5 & 6

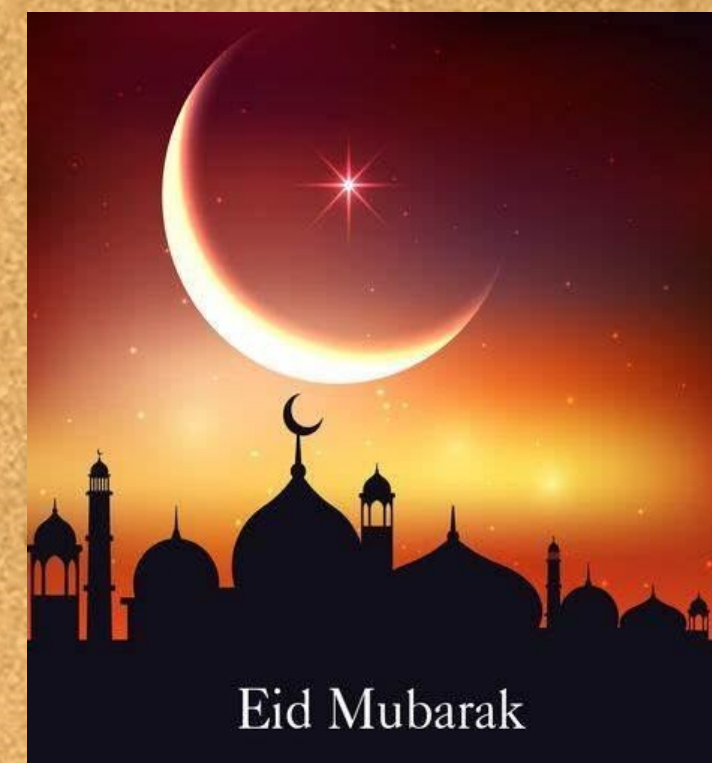


Our wonderful hard working Year 6's will be sitting their SAT's the week beginning Tuesday 9th May.
