English

This half term we will be studying the fictional text 'Cloud Tea Monkey's'. We will be focusing on conjunctions and prepositions. We will be writing a letter as our final outcome.

Following this, we will be studying another fictional text 'The Firework Maker's Daughter.' We will be writing an eyewitness account, using the first person and past tense.

French

We will be continuing our French lessons—we will be learning how to say animal names. We will learn how to ask simple questions, for example 'what is it?'

RE

Theme: Passover and Moses

Concept: Freedom

Passover is remembered by most Jewish people through a Seder plate meal. It is usually celebrated for 1 week in April.

PSHE

This half term we are going to cover how information is stored and used. Also, how to assess and access the reliability of information. In order, to be able to protect ourselves on line.

Music

They will continue to work on their reading of music notation and will improvise their own patterns to fit in with a beat.

Reading

Maths
