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Learning

English

We will be looking at the following texts:

The Secret Garden

Emergency Zoo

We will be writing a story linked to the Secret Garden and a persuasive letter linked to Emergency Zoo.

Reading

We will be reading Emergency Zoo and focusing on reading with fluency and expression, and practising our key reading skills.

French

In French, we will be learning about the celebration of Epiphany, as well as how to talk about our family and parts of the body.

Maths

We will be learning about:

- Multiplication and Division
- Area of rectilinear shapes
- Fractions

RE

We are looking at the theme of 'Ritual' and Hindu rites of passage.

Music
